Haugland Learning Center is excited to formally announce a new partnership with NECCO Center, a psychiatric residential treatment program located in Pedro, Ohio. HLC will take over all educational operations for NECCO Center's 45 residents by providing services on their campus as a day program.

NECCO Center provides high-quality treatment and care to male individuals from the tri-state area of Ohio, Kentucky, and West Virginia, ages 10-21. They offer a continuum of care that puts the individual needs of children first and they work collaboratively to ensure that programming is targeted and closely monitored. Above all, they strive to help youth gain the skills needed to live more independently in less restrictive, community based settings.

Haugland Learning Center (HLC) serves the educational needs of children with developmental disabilities throughout the state of Ohio via classroom-based and home-based programs. HLC's mission is to provide a safe and appropriate place where children with developmental disabilities can be successful and maximize their potential.

Because NECCO Center's mission is so similar HLC's, it's only natural that the two programs fit together well. As a result, the HLC-NECCO Center partnership is expected to create a new standard for service delivery to troubled youth in residential treatment facilities.
